Reinstatement of the long-notice RERT consultation paper

PIAC supports the rule change proposal to the extent that it will allow AEMO to access a broader and more robust set of potential providers for the Reliability and Emergency Reserve Trader (RERT). This will help ensure that, if AEMO chooses to exercise the RERT, it has the best opportunity to meet any reliability shortfall and at least cost.

However, this does not diminish AEMO's responsibility in choosing if and when to exercise the RERT. PIAC maintains that mechanisms to ensure system security and reliability such as the RERT must only be exercised when it is in the long-term interests of consumers.
